

Short Description of Project

To replace two of the existing candelabra lights with new candelabra lights with a higher lumen output and wider light distribution. The new lights will improve the light levels near the Nave altar, the pulpit and the lectern. It will also mean that additional lights are not necessary when the church is being used for concerts and other performances. The lights will be dimmable. A single candelabra was manufactured as a trial and temporarily erected in the centre of the aisle. This was shown to the PCC and got enthusiastic approval. The candelabra are examples of an overall scheme to improve the lighting in the church, where 15 of the same candelabra are proposed. The full design of the overall lighting is underway but not yet completed. The scheme will improve the nave and chancel lighting with LED strip and spots but will require a re-wiring of the church, which is not part of this application. We want to install these candelabras as soon as possible and before the nights become dark. This application sits with the proposal to improve the lighting for the choir, which is also being made.
